Available Positions

Treasurer: This position involves managing the financials of our charity. It is expected that the Treasurer has experience in handling financials and is familiar with grant applications, insurance, banking, and budgeting. The Treasurer is expected to attend monthly meetings and work closely with committee members to help this charity run smoothly.

Artistic Design: This position involves designing logos, posters, and presentations to help promote this charity, and create awareness of involved social issues. It is expected that the Artistic Designer has experience using design software and powerpoint. The Artistic Designer is encouraged to attend monthly meetings.

Tech Design: This position involves managing the website and assisting with social media. It is expected that the Tech Designer has experience using Wordpress, Facebook, and Instagram.

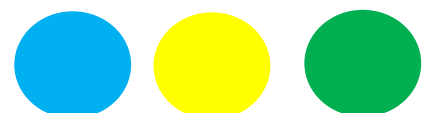

Harmony Day Planning Committee: Members of this committee are responsible for organising our annual Harmony Day event, now in partnership with the Bracken Ridge Lions. This committee will meet several times in the months leading up to the event in March 2024 to discuss the logistics and any new ideas that will help make this event great. Members are expected to attend these meetings and volunteer on the day.

General Member: If none of the above positions suit you, then you can still join us. General members are not required to attend monthly meetings but are encouraged to be involved whenever they can in our array of activities suited for your passions and interests.

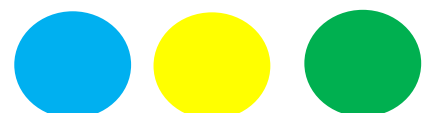
